## Master's Message

#### Brothers,

February, 2nd month in both the Julian and Gregorian calendars, is the shortest month and the only with fewer than 30 days. The month has 28 days in common years, 29 days in leap years, as in 2012. February was named after the Latin term februum, meaning purification via purification ritual Februa held on February 15 (full moon) in the old lunar Roman calendar. Historical names include Old English terms Solmonath (mud month) and Kale-monath (named for cabbage); also Charlemagne's designation Hornung. In Finnish, the month is called helmikuu, meaning "month of the pearl"; when snow melts on tree branches, it forms droplets, and as these freeze again, they are like pearls of ice. In Polish and Ukrainian, respectively, the month is called luty or лютий, meaning the month of ice or hard frost.

As we look forward we have much to accomplish. We have several new candidates for the Entered Apprentice Degree; we have two EAs needing proficiencies to progress. Scott Myers just completed his Degree and we are awaiting his proficiency for the 3rd Degree.

I have requested an Official Visit from the new Grand Master, Most Worshipful Karl Hinkle, and am hoping that he will grace our Lodge with his entourage. I've asked the officers to be fully prepared for the visit, since the last official visit was in the 1970's. We have a wonderful Lodge and we have a lot to show to Masonry in Colorado.
