# Master's Message

The feel of Fall is upon us with cool evenings and moderate daytime temperatures.

October is the 10th month in the Gregorian calendar. Its name from the Latin numeral 'octo' meaning 'eight'; in the first Roman calendar it was the 8th month. The 1st frost usually occurs in October. We will still have warm days ahead. Daylight Savings Time ends at 2am the last Sunday of October. German Oktoberfest (now held around the world) originally began on Oct 17, 1810; wedding day of King Ludwig I. In England the month was once named "Winmonth", which meant wine month. It has also been called 'Teo-monath' (10th month) and 'Winter-fylleth' (Winter full moon) in Old Saxon traditions. Other celebrations occur this month; Columbus Day, honoring the arrival of Columbus to the New World; and Halloween. Halloween is one of the oldest celebrations, dating back over 2000 years to Celtic times. According "Druid" religion, November 1st was the New Year. The celebration would begin Oct 31st and last into the next day. The spirits of all dead the prior year rise up to roam earth this night. Halloween was referred to as 'All Hallows' Eve. Originating from the pagan holiday honoring the dead. The Irish carved turnips with coals or small candles inside and placed outside their homes to ward off evil spirits. They also used potatoes or rutabagas. However, when Irish immigrants came to America, they quickly discovered that pumkins were much easier to carve into Jack O'Lanterns. This quickly spread in America and elsewhere. Some Protestants celebrate Reformation Day, the anniversary of Oct 31, 1517, when Martin Luther's published his 95 theses triggering the Protestant Reformation. Starting a decades-long war in Europe, between Catholics and Protestants, and the eventual fracture of Christianity.
